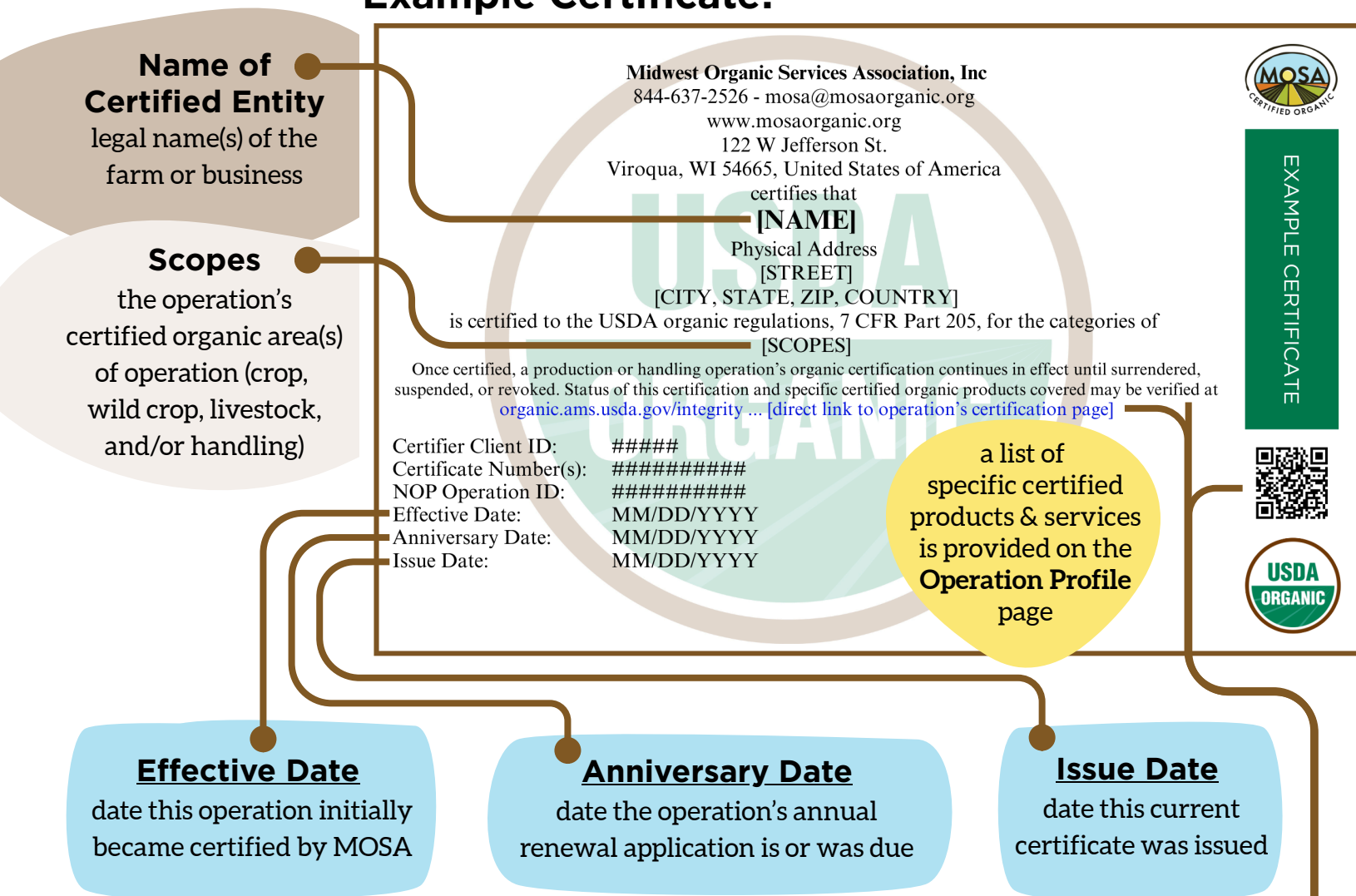


# What's on the **ORGANIC CERTIFICATE?**

Each certified organic operation receives an organic certificate, which provides essential information about their certification. Certificates are generated online in the [USDA Organic Integrity Database \(OID\)](#). You can access the OID to verify the current organic status of any entity. Pull up a certificate from one of your suppliers to follow along!


## Example Certificate:



"Once certified, a production or handling...", link to the operation profile, and QR code


### **Organic Certificates do not expire**

Organic certification ends when: surrendered by the client.  
suspended or revoked by the certifier.


Click the [blue link](#) on the certificate or scan the  QR code to verify the operation's current certification status on the USDA Organic Integrity Database (OID). From the OID, select [\[Print Certificate\]](#) in the upper right corner to download the current certificate.

# Example Operation Profile:

The Operation Profile in the Organic Integrity Database (OID) includes a list of each client's certified organic products and services and is considered public information. A MOSA client's Certificate and Operation Profile can both be downloaded as PDFs from the OID. MOSA also provides clients the Certified Organic Products and Services (COPS) form for added detail about their certified products.
