Hemp Affirmation Purpose:

Hemp production is subject to state and federal laws and regulations. This Hemp Affirmation confirms that it is your responsibility to comply with all applicable laws and regulations.

Background information:

MOSA uses the Agriculture Improvement Act of 2018 (2018 Farm Bill) as guidance on Organic Certification of Hemp Production.

The Agricultural Marketing Act of 1946 (<u>7 U.S.C. 1621 et seq</u>.) was amended by adding the following: "SEC. 297A. DEFINITIONS.

"(1) HEMP.-The term 'hemp' means the plant Cannabis sativa L. and any part of that plant, including the seeds thereof and all derivatives, extracts, cannabinoids, isomers, acids, salts and salts of isomers, whether growing or not, with a delta-9 tetrahydrocannabinol concentration of not more than 0.3 percent on a dry weight basis.

MOSA's synopsis of the 2018 Farm Bill, regarding hemp, is as follows:

- Reclassifies hemp as an agricultural commodity instead of a controlled substance;
- Allows hemp production in all 50 states for any use, including flower production and CBD or other cannabinoid extraction:
- States will have the option to submit their own plans to regulate hemp;
- Allows interstate commerce of hemp and hemp products;
- Gives the industry access to federally backed farm support programs, including crop insurance, federal water access and low-interest loans for new farmers.
